
THE UNESCO MAB (MAN AND BIOSPHERE) PROGRAMME

The UNESCO Man and the Biosphere (MAB) programme, which was established in 1971, is an intergovernmental framework aiming to lay the scientific foundations to improve the relationship between man and the environment.

The MAB Programme merges the practical application of natural and social sciences, economics and education to protect biodiversity, natural and man-made ecosystems, promoting the sustainable development of territories from an economic, social and environmental perspective.

Maintaining and strengthening the existing land management model, based on both the deep rootedness of resident communities alongside the low environmental impact of human activities




JULIAN ALPS **BIOSPHERE** RESERVE
